An addendum, here is an example of what could be done:

Wrap birthday boxes for food banks with birthday supplies for those using food banks (candles, cake mix, disposable pan, frosting, can of Sprite and possible miscellaneous items like napkins or balloons or whatever in the cake pan wrapped with a bow. Include a card that says, "Happy Birthday! To make a cake without eggs, oil and water, mix 1 can of Sprite with the cake mix. That's it! Bake according to back of box."
